DSCO makes additional donation of £300 to Broxbourne based BODbus (Broxbourne Organisation for Disabled) charity.

For several years now, DSCO has been supporting BODbus, a local charity staffed entirely by volunteers. The charity runs six vehicles that have been altered to be accessible for wheelchair-bound clients. The service is offered free of charge and relies on donations to keep going.

Some of the vehicles require a professional driver, others can be driven by the clients themselves.

Following a meeting with Shane Lukas of AVN Consultants, who had been working with DSCO on strategic business development, Shane and David decided that instead of paying AVN for their services, DSCO would donate to BODbus instead, resulting in an additional donation of £300.
